

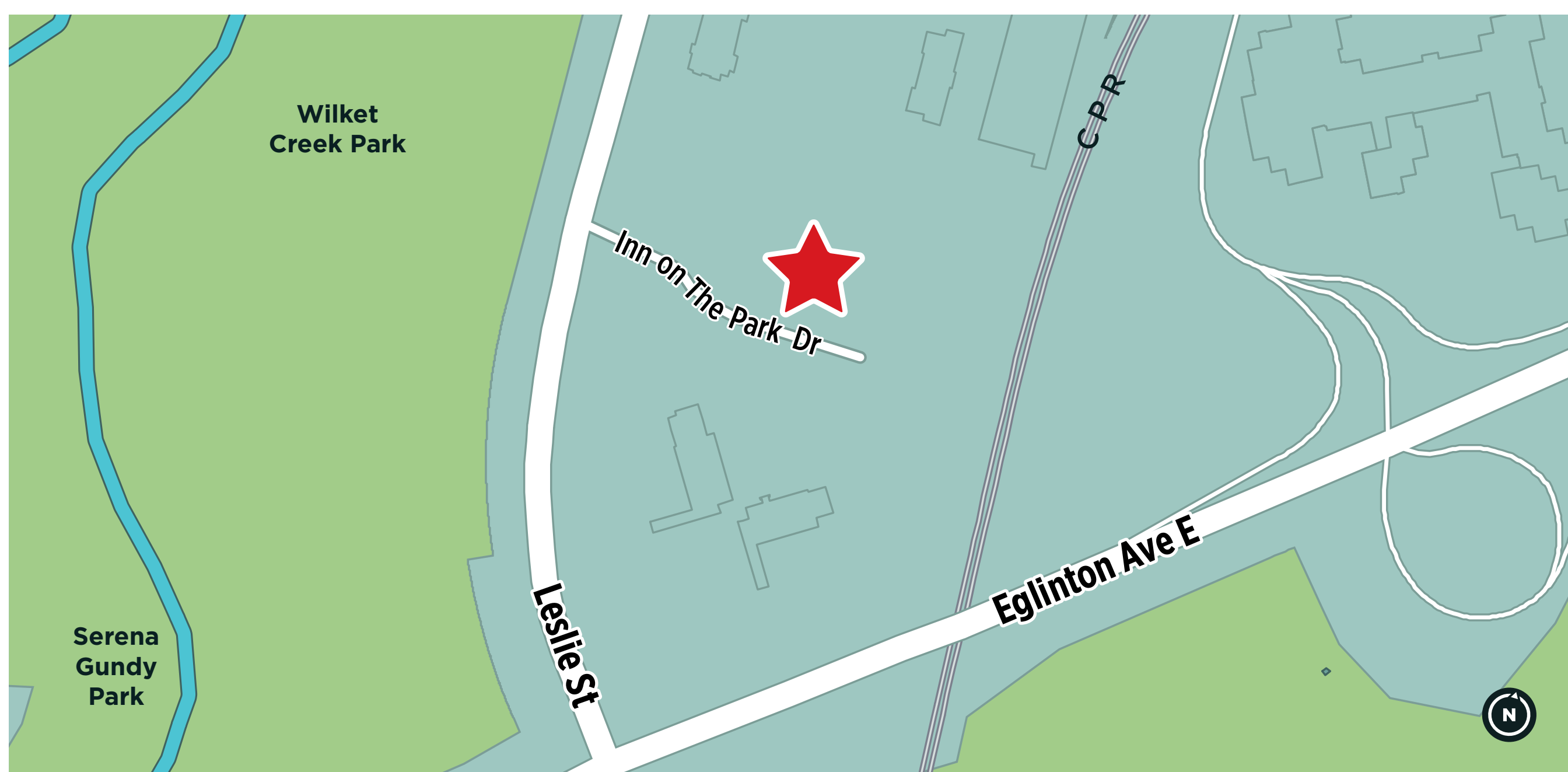
New park coming to 1087 Leslie St
